Please note that I have moved to a new address in southern Oregon. A post office box is not available here yet, so until they have one I will use General Delivery. If you use my old Colorado Springs address the mail will be forwarded but I'll receive it later, so I would prefer that you send your bid sheets here.

TERMS OF SALE

- 1) This is a mail bid sale, and each lot will be sold to the highest bidder. I do not accept buy bids, percentage increases, or other unusual bids; if you bid highest, you win the lot.
- 2) On all lots that sell for over \$10.00, the high bid will be reduced to a figure that is 10% above the second high bid for that lot. For example, if you are high bidder at \$100 for a certain lot, and the next highest bid is \$70, you have to pay only 10% above the \$70, a total of \$77. (10% of \$70 is \$7, so you pay \$70 + \$7, which equals \$77.) So you may bid generously if you particularly want to win certain lots, knowing that there's a good chance that a number of your bids may be reduced, lowering your cost in the pieces.
- 3) Items in this sale are absolutely guaranteed to be genuine and as I have described them. If I have made an error in cataloging I will gladly correct it to your satisfaction. However, you too must be responsible for your errors, so please check your bid sheet carefully before sending it to me. Auction sales are not approval sales.
- 4) For many lots I will provide an estimate of value in parentheses. These values are only guides that tell you my idea of the worth of the lots, so they are not necessarily the prices at which the lots will sell. Most lots will naturally sell at a figure that is somewhat above or somewhat below the estimate. I do reserve the right to reject ridiculous bids such as a bid that is far below normal dealer buying price, or blanket bids of 5¢ for every lot in the sale, and so forth.
- 5) Bids should be made in U.S. dollars, and payment for lots that you win is due when you receive your invoice for the lots. I retain title to each lot until I have received payment in full for it, at which time I will ship it to you immediately. Regular clients may receive their lots with the invoice if our schedule permits. PAYMENT MUST BE IN U.S. DOLLARS. I'm sorry I cannot accept payment in Mexican pesos from my Mexican friends, but my bank takes over a month to collect these funds for me, and discounts them as well.
- 6) Persons who have not done business with us before are asked to please furnish satisfactory credit references or send a deposit of 20% of the total of their bids. Naturally, the deposit is subtracted from your invoice if you win lots, or is returned immediately if you do not.
- 7) Lots may be inspected at my bank if you wish at a time convenient for us both. Many of the bills in this sale are Gaytan catalog specimens, and I have given photographs of most of them as well. If you desire a further photograph of any bill in the auction, feel free to let me know, and I can have one for you in a few days.
- 8) Please use the bid sheet provided, and feel free to bid on as many lots as you wish. Please bid by lot number, and if you run out of space on the bid sheet, use an additional sheet of paper. I have provided space on the bid sheet for special instructions, so let me know if there are special shipping instructions, etc. And let me know if you do not wish to spend over a certain total amount in the sale, or perhaps you will not want to buy a lot unless you also win a certain other lot in the same series. Sometimes there are things bidders wish to state, so go ahead.

MAIL BID SALE OF MEXICAN PAPER MONEY

THIS IS OUR SECOND MAJOR SALE OF MEXICAN BILLS - the first was held on November 30, 1974, and it contained 1275 lots, many of which were taken from the largest collection of Mexican paper money ever assembled. Because the mail service was slow to several areas of Mexico, some of the bills did not sell in the auction, plus we have purchased a number of rare items since then, so here we offer another major group in this very popular field.

INCLUDED ARE MANY RARE ITEMS, GAYTAN ILLUSTRATION BILLS used in his standard catalogs, uncataloged bills, and other hard-to-find pieces. The field is very active these days, so this is probably about the last chance to pick up some of these rarities - after this stock is sold, I don't know where I'll find further groups of this rarity to offer. I've found that most of these bills sell better in Mexico than they used to, so now there are major markets for any scarce items in both of our countries.

THERE MAY BE VARIATIONS ON THE ABOVE, but generally you'll see them follow this pattern. Bills that are the actual pieces used to illustrate the Gaytan books are noted with GAYTAN PHOTO BILL, and you'll find plenty of them in the sale.

A FEW WORDS ABOUT RARITY OF MEXICAN BILLS -

There are some 2800 major types of Mexican paper money! The majority of them are very scarce to extremely rare, and here's an example of how few most of us have seen: Although I've been the leading dealer and researcher in the field in the U.S. for over 10 years, I had owned fewer than 500 of the types until I bought the largest collection ever formed last year. It contained some 2000 of the types, so I had never seen 3/4 of the bills before.

This sale contains many of the bills I'm speaking of, and I can assure you that they are rare, and that a number of them are undoubtedly the only examples of their types known to exist. In the provisional and private issues we are not certain yet of number of pieces known for most types because they have not been studied in detail, but in the bank bills I have recorded every example seen by myself and other researchers for some 10-12 years now. Naturally, in the bank pieces, especially those printed by the American Bank Note Company, prices have advanced, and a real steal is not found in a major sale, but even these bills are priced very low for their rarity when compared with other fields.

The real bargains are found in the strange little cardboard fractional pieces, where a unique or fewer-than-five-known item often sells at \$10 to \$40! Wise collectors who buy these now will have good money on their hands a few years from now when major catalogs of these rare items are issued.

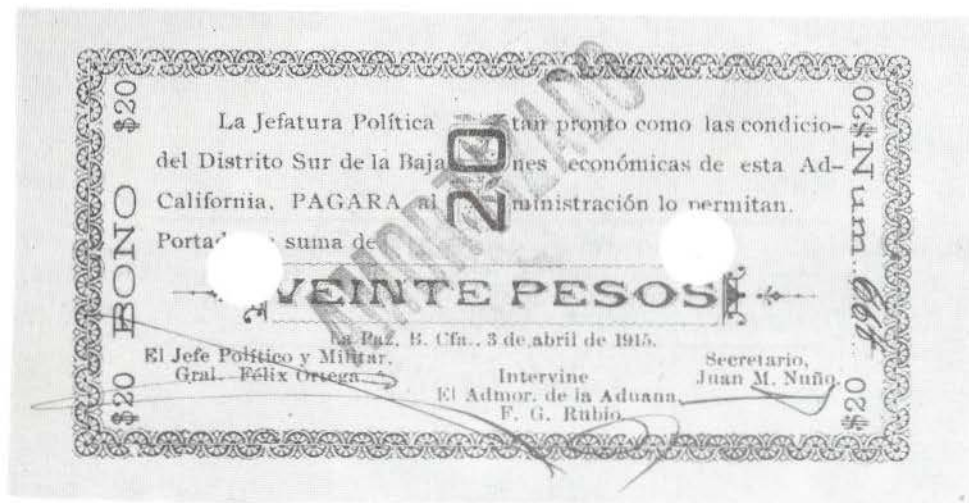

- 1) BCAL-15 \$20 4-3-15 #664 GAYTAN PHOTO BILL AU with two punch cancellations. Purple stamp AMORTIZADO obv. Only example of this bill I know to exist, and the first piece of this series I have ever owned; from the largest collection ever formed. Any bill of Baja California is scarce except for the Gobierno Constitucionalista pieces of August 21, 1914, and this bill is probably unique! A real prize for the small price it will bring. (\$60-\$80)

- 2) uncat 10¢ undated #8538 Beautiful hand signed dark grey heavy cardboard bill measuring 41x58mm. Rev bears partial blue company seal and the red seal of Aduana Maritime, Santa Rosalia, B.C. CHOICE AU but for small piece of paper glued to rev partially covering red seal; can probably be removed. A NICE BILL and PROBABLY UNIQUE! Another good buy at today's prices. (\$25-\$40)

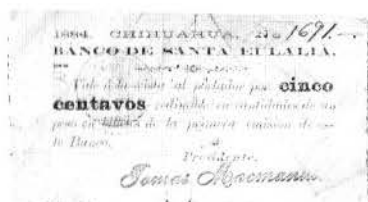

EL BANCO DE SANTA EULALIA

- 3) CHIH-1 5¢ 1884 #1691 This bill was not cataloged in Gaytan's 1965 edition, then it was listed but not illustrated in his 1972 edition. Three examples are known to exist: one resides in a collection in Canada, a second in Mexico, and the third is offered here. Condition is VG, beginning to tear at center crease. VERY RARE (\$250-\$400)

- 4) CHIH-4 \$1 1875 A #51587 This series is very popular with collectors of Mexican bills, and owning an example is like having a really nice trilobite in a fossil collection: it's always one of your favorites. Hand signed by L H Scott; nice vignettes of ranchers roping cattle and an old-time locomotive on obverse. Good condition, nice clean bill that appears in better condition at first glance. (\$100-\$150)

EL BANCO DE CHIHUAHUA

- 5) CHIH-19 50¢ 1875 B #19940 GAYTAN PHOTO BILL One of two examples known; both are G-VG condition, hand signature of Contador, Series B. There is a unique \$1 bill Series A, 1874, and these are the only three representatives of this early series known to date. EXCESSIVELY RARE BILL, and probably the only one that will be offered, as the other 50¢ and the \$1 are in a large collection that will probably never be broken. A very unusual opportunity. (\$500-\$800)

- 6) CHIH-27 \$5 B 1898 #16274 Branch overprint GOMEZ PALACIO
Only Poor condition, but an EXTREMELY RARE BILL - in over 10 years of study I've recorded only six examples. (\$75-\$100)
- 7) CHIH-28 \$10 B 10-20-98 #1210 Branch overprint GOMEZ PALACIO
EXTREMELY RARE; six examples known Poor condition, hand sgd (\$75-\$100)
- 8) CHIH-30 \$50 B 10-20-98 #0104 Branch overprint GOMEZ PALACIO
Ten examples known; several are in museums. Hand sgd Good (\$250)

EL BANCO DE HIDALGO, PARRAL

- 9) uncat 25¢ A 1883 #12363 Bills from this bank are rare - the 1965 Gaytan catalog mentions the founding of the bank but states that no bills were known in collections; then the 1972 catalog mentions the bank again but makes no mention of bills. Meantime, I had cataloged the pieces in an article in World Coins in 1966. See my November 1974 auction catalog for information on numbers known of each denomination through the \$10. I have recorded five examples of this 25¢ bill; this one G-VG (\$500)
- 10) uncat 50¢ A 1883 #831 Four issued examples known plus a few unissued proofs and a specimen bill. Good EXTREMELY RARE (\$500)

- 11) CHIH-31 5¢ 1884 #3586 GAYTAN PHOTO BILL One of three examples known to exist. Printed in black on cream ledger paper, with stamped signature of Manager Enrique C Creel. Reverse bears black seal of Administracion Gral de Rentas, Estado de Chihuahua, plus blue seal of the bank with date ABR 16 1884. CHOICE XF-AU EXTREMELY RARE (\$250-\$400)
- 12) CHIH-31 5¢ 1884 #3735 As above but VERY CHOICE AU, probably never circulated but light handling by collectors (\$250-\$400)
- 13) CHIH-31B 10¢ 1884 #7 One of two examples known to exist! Printed in black on cream ledger paper; signature, seals as on 5¢ bills except date in blue is ABR 15 1884. Nice VG but has torn vertically, mended carefully with thin strip of transparent tape. (\$250-\$300)
- 14) CHIH-31B 10¢ 1884 #1361 GAYTAN PHOTO BILL As above 10¢, the other known example of the type. CRISP F-VF (\$250-\$400)
- 15) CHIH-31C 25¢ (1880) #227083 Overprint BATOPILAS One of four examples known of this o/p on this bill! Fair-Good (\$80)
- 16) CHIH-31C 25¢ (1880) #265882 Overprint BATOPILAS VG (\$100)
- 17) CHIH-31C 25¢ (1880) #289631 Overprint BATOPILAS VG (\$100)

- 18) CHIH-43 \$10 X.3 1910 #75223 Scarce and popular commemorative issue! Many countries issue commemorative bills today, but Mexico was one of very few to issue them prior to the last decade or so. These keep getting harder to find as collectors realize that they must have one to complete their commemorative set. Obverse same as regular issue \$10 of the bank, but reverse has beautiful and unusual green, white, and red Mexican flag design with Liberty Cap. NICE G-VG (\$50-\$60)

- 19) CHIH-49 50¢ 1914 #951140 Unsigned remainder of an EXTREMELY RARE BILL Three examples known; this one is VG-F. (\$175-\$200)

TESORERIA GENERAL DEL ESTADO Bills with name "General Francisco Villa"

- 20) CHIH-71 5¢ 12-10-13 B #99426 The scarcest bill of this popular series; Gaytan lists as value RARE! Nice clean VG (\$125-\$150)
- 21) CHIH-79,80,82 \$5,\$10,\$20 12-10-13 An unusual group of 20 bills, each with a different resello, including some scarce ones that seldom turn up. These resellos are revalidating stamps placed on bills by government or military authorities to show that the bills were valid currency in their particular area. They have not been studied in any detail yet, and wise collectors are buying them up, knowing they'll have some very good pieces soon. Overall average condition of lot is G-VG, and some have hand signatures of validating authority as well as overprints. (\$30-\$50)
- 22) Another lot as above lot 21 but 12 bills average cond G-VG, also includes a number of scarce, seldom-seen overprints and unusual hand signatures. I was very tempted to keep all these myself as a small investment for the future. (\$20-\$30)

- 23) COAH-4 \$50 R-2 3-3-98 #1729 Branch overprint TORREON; the only bill of this denomination I have seen with the overprint! Hand sgd; appears G-VG on obv but thin strip of tape vertically on rev. A VERY SCARCE item for overprint collectors. (\$50-\$75)
- 24) COAH-4 \$50 R-6 5-16-98 #5937 Hand sgd Fair, not bad (\$25)
- 25) COAH-4 \$50 R-7 3-5-00 #6205 Hand sgd Fair; looks G-VG on obv, but small pces white tape at top & bottom rev (\$25)

- 26) COAH-5 \$100 I-6 6-7-10 #5305 A VERY SCARCE BILL - I have recorded only 8 examples to date, and this is probably the best condition I have seen, a large beautiful orange, yellow, and black bill in very close to FINE condition! A real prize for the top-condition collection; hand signed as always for this denomination. Two pieces in Fair-Good in my November 1974 auction brought \$77 and \$103, so I should think that this one will bring something like (\$150-\$200)

BANCO DE LA LAGUNA/BANCO MINERO, Sucursal en Gomez Palacio

- 27) uncat \$50 A 12-18-13 #1580 A RARE UNCATALOGED BANK-TO-BANK BILL! Large beautiful blue, white bill, hand sgd, o/p CANCELADO. Never circulated but was wet at one time because signatures, overprint somewhat faded and bill bears light, wavy wrinkles and modest tan staining at edges. Printer TIP. C. MONTAURIOL, TORREON. Very nice looking piece, undoubtedly RARE. (\$90-\$125)

- 28) COAH-78 \$5 4-30-14 GAYTAN PHOTO BILL Poor, repaired on reverse.
Probably the only example known of this bill; certainly RARE. (\$80)

in the Torreon bank-to-bank bills of 1913. Nice hand sigs G-VG (\$40)

- 30) uncat 50¢ 9-25-15 #10081 Uniface green, red on white, 75x141mm,

Very pretty little bill with stamped signature VG-F

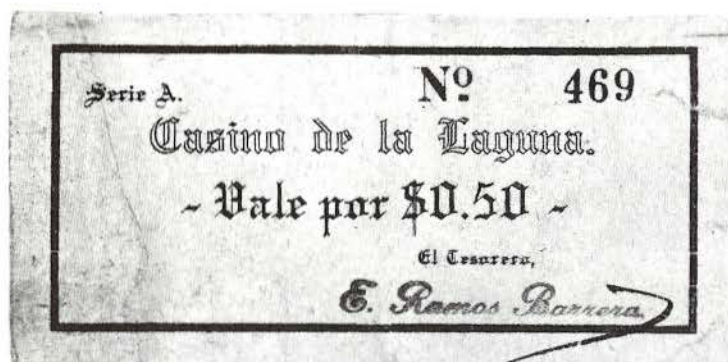

These are the post-Iturbide bills printed on the backs of old Papal Bulas, and we offer a \$1 and a \$2 of the regular large size. These are RARE items that are very much in demand by collectors today, and this pair is in particularly choice condition. A good opportunity to buy a genuinely rare bill or pair of bills while items like these are still underpriced for their rarity.

- 57) uncat \$1 5-5-1823 #124708 VERY CHOICE UNCIRCULATED with usual slight edge wrinkle or two. Nice condition for these large bills, which are often easily damaged. Measures 220x315mm (about 8½x12½ in.) (\$400)
- 58) uncat \$2 5-5-1823 #86008 Not quite as choice as the \$1; has very slight edge staining and fraying at a few places, but they are hard to see. Another pretty item. Both of these bear the usual single cut cancel at the bottom left. (\$400)

- 59) DGO-9 \$100 G 6-18-13 #0342 The \$100 of this bank catalogs at only \$64 in VF in Gaytan, but it has always been much scarcer than such a value would indicate. We know of but ten examples to date of this beautiful yellow, brown, and black bill with the sailing ship vignette. Missing from most collections, and surprisingly difficult to locate today. This piece is hand signed, rather Poor condition because torn and repaired with tape on rev, but looks nice on the front. (\$100)
- 60) DGO-9 \$100 H 3-1-14 #2115 BEST ONE I'VE EVER SEEN, a really pretty piece. Hand signed, with unusual wear - barely folded at all but edges bear wrinkles and beginning of slight fraying. The result is a very nice piece that appears in much better than the FINE grade I would assign to it. A real prize for your album. (\$200)

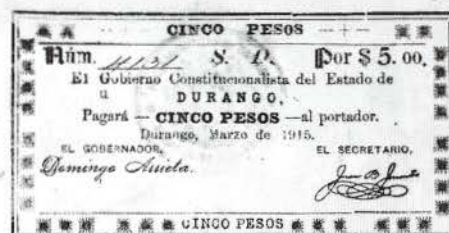

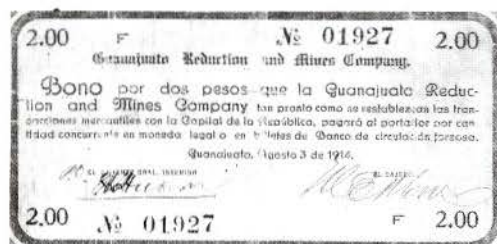

These are the very popular bills with the name BANK OF MONTREAL across the top, issued by the company and payable at the bank. The series has been in great demand since some 10 years ago, especially with collectors in Canada who want bank items. The name of the bank appears as the main device on each bill. I had had fewer than 10 or so bills of this group until my November 1974 sale which featured 16 pieces that were taken from the largest collection of bills of Mexico ever formed.

Now we offer more of this series after making a fortunate purchase at the recent convention in Mexico City. I cannot overstate the importance of these pieces - they have been nearly impossible to find in recent years, and demand is very high. Of all the lots in my November 1974 auction, these brought the most spirited bids.
